## Traditional Games



Texas Hold'em

Two cards are dealt. Five community cards (3, 1, 1)



Omaha Hold'em

Four cards are dealt. Players MUST USE 2 CARDS. Five community cards (3, 1, 1)



Omaha Hold'em 8-or-Better

Omaha Hold'em. High-low split game. Low is possible if an 8-low hand can be made. Traditionally, A-5 is best low.



Seven Card Stud

Seven card are dealt. (2d+1u, 1u, 1u, 1u, 1d)



Razz (7 Card Stud Low)

Seven card stud. Low is traditionally A-5 low. Straights and flushes do not count. Variation: 2-7 low.



Seven Card Stud 8-or-Better

Seven card stud. High-low split game. Low is possible if an 8-low hand can be made. Traditionally, A-5 is best low.



Five Card Draw

Five cards dealt. Players can draw (exchange cards).



Lowball (5 Card Draw Low)

Five cards draw. Low is traditionally A-5. Straights and flushes don't count. Variation: 2-7 low.

## Non-Standard Games



Pineapple Hold'em

Hold'em Variation. Three cards are dealt. One card is discarded immediately at deal.



Crazy Pineapple Hold'em

Hold'em Variation. Three cards are dealt. One card is discarded after the flop.



2-7 Lowball Triple Draw

Five card draw. Three rounds of drawing cards. "Kansas City" Low: Straights and flushes count. Aces are high.



Double Draw

Two rounds of drawing cards.

## New Variants



Virginia Hold'em

Deal: 2 cards down (player)  
Flop: 2 cards community  
Turn: 2 cards up (player)  
River: 1 card community



Houston Stud

Deal: 2 cards down (player)  
Flop: 3 cards up (player)  
Turn: 1 card up (player)  
River: 1 card up (player)



Open Draw (Double-Draw)

Deal: 2 cards down, 3 cards up (player)  
Second Round: Draw cards.  
Final Round: Draw cards.

All players declare which cards are to be traded before any cards are dealt. Discarded up cards receive up cards, and vice versa.
